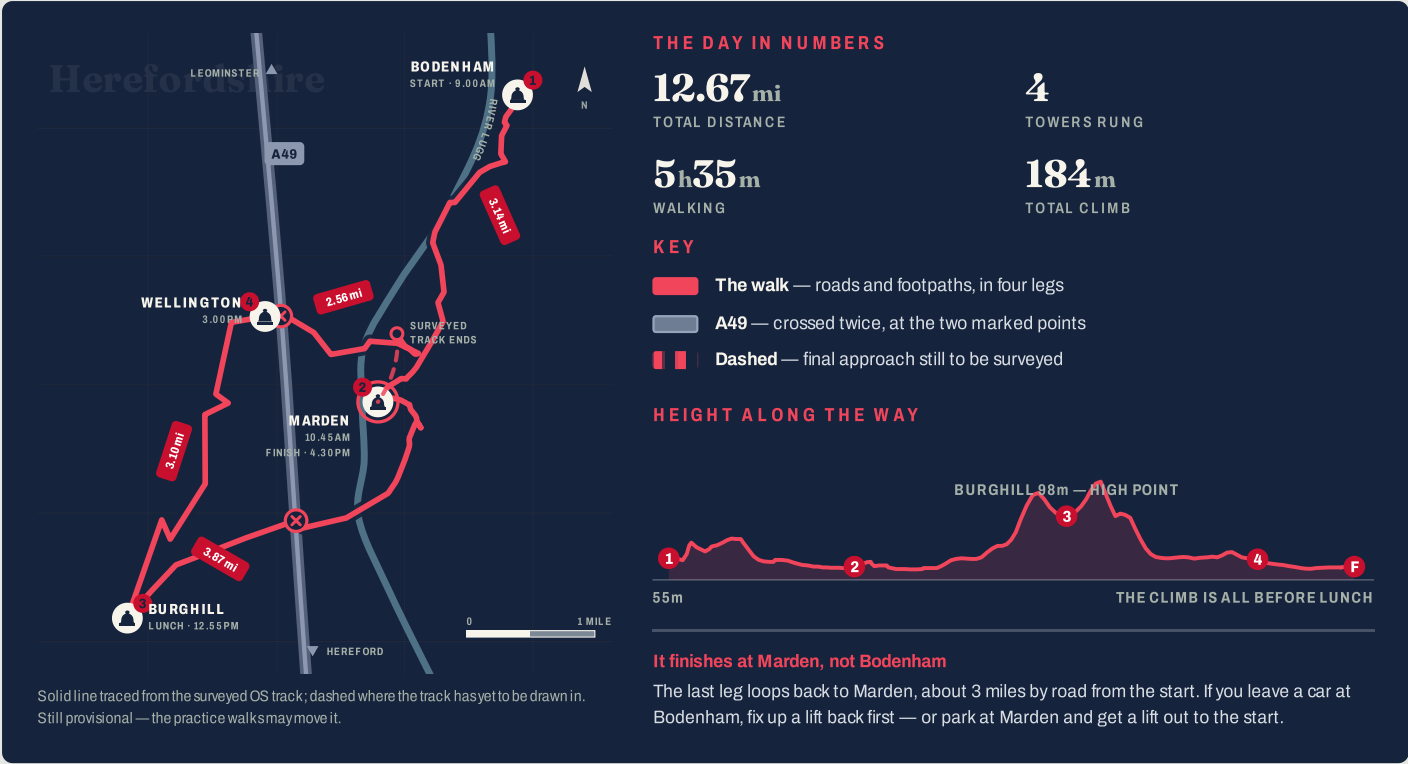


SPONSORED WALK & RINGING DAY — EVERYONE WELCOME

Bodenham ⚐ Marden ⚐ Burghill ⚐ Wellington ⚐ Marden

Four Herefordshire towers in one day, on foot, with **ringing at every one**. Walk the whole 12.67 miles, take a single leg, ring a touch, or just turn up at a tower to see everyone through. You don't need sponsors to join in.



THE DAY		Ringling opens a few minutes before the walkers are due — join either
9.00 – 9.30am	Bodenham ST MICHAEL & ALL ANGELS	Meet and ring. Walkers leave at 9.20am.
3.14 miles	Bodenham to Marden · about 1h 25m	
10.40 – 11.10am	Marden ST MARY THE VIRGIN	Walkers due 10.45am. Leave at 11.10am.
3.87 miles	Marden to Burghill · about 1h 45m · crosses the A49	
12.50 – 1.20pm	Burghill ST MARY THE VIRGIN	Walkers due 12.55pm. Ringing and lunch run together — bring your own. Leave at 1.40pm.
3.10 miles	Burghill to Wellington · about 1h 20m	
2.55 – 3.25pm	Wellington ST MARGARET OF ANTIOCH	Walkers due 3.00pm. Leave at 3.25pm.
2.56 miles	Wellington to Marden · about 1h 05m · crosses the A49	
about 4.30pm	Marden FINISH	All four towers rung and 12.67 miles walked.
